

Cwtsh Cynnes – special permission sheet

Emergency medical treatment: if the child requires treatment urgently and the parents cannot be contacted within a reasonable time, to prevent possible hazard, permission is given for any necessary medical treatment by a qualified doctor and/or nurse.

Administering medication: in order for nursery staff to administer any medication to a child, a medication permission form **must** be filled in and signed by the parent/guardian. This form must be completed each time the medication is to be administered. All medication must be in its original container and clearly labelled with the child's name, date and dosage. If your child becomes unwell during their time at the nursery staff will make every effort to contact you, if you wish your child to receive calpol to give them some comfort until they are collected written permission is needed, by signing this form you are giving your written consent for calpol to be administered if it is needed.

Use of skin creams, nappies, wipes, and suntan lotion: permission is given for nursery staff to administer the above to my child if and when needed. Suntan lotion is to be provided by parents/guardians and is to be clearly labelled with the child's name; staff are given permission to apply when needed.

Photographs and video clips: permission is given for nursery staff to take photographs and video clips of my child in accordance with the settings policies and procedures and used for work purposes only.

I/we agree to the terms and conditions outlined above and all policies and procedures of the nursery are always available on request for parents to read. These may be amended from time to time to keep up to date with the latest regulations.
